

HP Pavilion

The HP Pavilion at San Jose's convenient downtown location allows ticket holders to take full advantage of an urban setting -- with fine dining, bustling cafes and clubs, and a host of transportation alternatives. It's a win-win situation.

The HP Pavilion at San Jose has been a boom to the downtown economy; and its setting invites patrons to make the most of a safe, compact and revitalized city center.

Twin Creeks Sports Complex

Twins Creeks has established itself as the world's premier location for softball leagues and tournaments. The 60-acre complex also attracts corporate events and picnics from the Silicon Valley's finest companies. Twin Creeks also hosts flag football and soccer leagues and tournaments. The complex was established in 1985 and has 10 lighted Softball batting cages as well as a Barbecue area with a full Catering Service and Banquet Facility. It also has a 14,000 square ft. Clubhouse with a Video Arcade and Playground Kids Games. In addition, the Clubhouse has 20 televisions.

Shoreline Amphitheatre

The Shoreline Amphitheatre is located in Mountain View and is 10 miles North of San Jose and 35 miles South from San Francisco. Shoreline boasts one of the world's largest Tent structures, state-of-the-art sound systems and a helpful and friendly staff who make as many as 22,000 people per event feel safe, happy and comfortable.

San Jose Tech Museum

The Tech Museum of Innovation engages people of all ages and backgrounds in exploring and experiencing the technologies affecting their lives, and aims to inspire the innovator in everyone. An expansive variety of interactive exhibits and unique floor programs showcase not just how technology works, but how it affects who we are and how we live, work, play and learn. The Tech's 132,000 square feet are divided among themed galleries focused on innovation, the internet, the human body, and exploration. In addition, The Tech also features the Hackworth IMAX Dome Theater (Northern California's only domed IMAX screen), an educational center for workshops and labs, an up scale cafe, and a retail store featuring books, gifts, and only-in-Silicon Valley items.

Annually, The Tech plays host to roughly 400,000 guests - 80,000 of whom visit as part of a school field trip - making it one of California's most popular destinations.

The Tech is more than just a museum. Signature programs include Tech Challenge, an annual student design competition founded in 1988, and The Tech Museum Awards, which honors and awards people around the world who use technology to benefit humanity. Additionally, The Tech offers award-winning online exhibits, and the Robert N. Noyce Center for Learning, which encourages innovation and experimentation among teachers and students.

Winchester Mystery House

Tour through 110 of the 160 rooms and look for the bizarre phenomena that gave the mansion its name; a window built into the floor, staircases leading to nowhere, a chimney that rises four floors, doors that open onto blank walls, and upside down posts! No one has been able to explain the mysteries that exist within the Winchester Mansion, or why Sarah Winchester kept the carpenters' hammers pounding 24 hours a day for 38 years. It is believed that after the untimely deaths of her baby daughter and husband, son of the Winchester Rifle manufacturer, Mrs. Winchester was convinced by a medium that continuous building would appease the evil spirits of those killed by the famous "Gun that Won the West" and help her attain eternal life. Certainly her \$20,000,000 inheritance was sufficient to support her obsession until her death at 82!

A visit to the Winchester Mystery House is not complete until you have strolled through the beautiful Victorian gardens that surround it. Great care has been taken to restore the grounds to that time when Sarah Winchester had a full-time staff of eight gardeners, and imported trees, shrubs, and flowers from all parts of the world. Nearly 14,000 miniature boxwood hedges, large

flowering Carolina cherry laurels, plants, and flowers have been replanted to provide beautiful color year-round. Numerous handcrafted European lead statues and elaborate fountains have been restored. You will see the original mythological statues including Mother Nature, Cupid, a cherub, hippocampus, American Indian, deer, egret, frogs and swans. Mrs. Winchester's fascination with the supernatural is evident in the gardens, where you can count 13 California Fan Palms lining the front driveway! The self-guided Garden Tour includes a guide map and narrative tapes at the 10 major points of interest. Guests also see the green house, garage, car wash, pump and tank houses. Wheel chaired guests are invited to tour the Gardens and Historic Firearms Museum as our guests and at no charge (unfortunately the Mansion Tour is NOT accessible to wheel chairs or infant strollers.)

California Theater

The newly renovated California Theatre celebrated its grand re-opening in September 2004. Originally built in 1927, the 1,119-seat movie palace, located in the heart of downtown San Jose, has been transformed into not only a major performing arts center but also a lavish conference and meeting facility. Additional meeting rooms, with state-of-the-art audio and video technology, have been added to the original structure.

South Hall

South Hall, the San Jose Convention & Cultural Facilities' new \$6.7 million venue, expands San Jose's meeting and exhibit space from 143,000 to 223,000 square feet. Civic Auditorium

Located directly across the street from the San Jose McEnery Convention Center, the auditorium features 3,001 seats in concert form and four meeting rooms. The auditorium provides additional exhibit and general assembly space in conjunction with the convention center and Parkside Hall.
